

Call for Scientific Abstracts and Clinical Cases

Important Dates

- Deadline for submitting scientific abstracts and clinical cases: December 15, 2025
- Notification of acceptance/rejection of your abstract/case: December 30, 2025.

Submission Rules

- 1. Each person is permitted to submit and be the first author on one scientific and one clinical case abstract. You may co-author as many other abstracts as desired.
- 2. The first-named author must present the abstract.
- 3. All authors must approve the submitted abstract.
- 4. The primary focus and substance of the submitted abstract/case must be novel.
- 5. Authors who use artificial intelligence (AI) tools in the writing of a manuscript, production of images or graphical elements of the paper, or in the collection and analysis of data, must be transparent in disclosing on the submission site and slides/poster presentation how the AI tool was used, and which tool was used. Authors are fully responsible for the content of their manuscript, even those parts produced by an AI tool, and are thus liable for any breach of publication ethics.
- 6. Presenters agree to pay the meeting registration fee and any other costs associated with presenting at the Symposium.
- 7. Abstracts will be published in the Symposium Proceedings

 Scientific Abstract and Clinical Case submission fee: \$25 (will be deducted from the Symposium Cost if accepted, and the first author attends the Symposium).

 Triple Payment

Preparing the Abstract

A) Research Abstracts

- Abstract character count is limited to 2,000 characters (not including spaces, title or author block).
 Tables, charts and graphs count as 300 characters.
- Indicate grant-funding/Al acknowledgements in the appropriate field during submission.
- The abstract must be written in English and grammatically correct.

Title: The title should be brief (<15 words) and in title case format.

Authors: First names and then last names of the authors. Do not include degree titles.

Institutions: Include all authors' institutional affiliations. Do not include departments.

Text: The abstract must be informative, including a statement of the study's specific PURPOSE, METHODS, summary of RESULTS, and CONCLUSION statement using these headings.

B) Clinical Case or Work Experience Abstract

Clinical case or Work Experience abstracts are limited to 2,000 characters (not including spaces, title or author block).

Your abstract should include a synopsis of your case or work experience that itself includes: the history and physical exam (if applicable) of the case to be discussed; final/working diagnosis; and treatment/outcomes as they pertain to the case.

Title: The title should be brief (<15 words) and in title case format.

Authors: First names and then last names of the authors. Do not include degree titles.

Institutions: Include all authors' institutional affiliations. Do not include departments.

Text: The first paragraph should state the history of the case or work experience; the second paragraph should list:

- Working Diagnosis
- Treatment and Outcomes
